- 2) Staff members attempt to contact the child's other parent or an alternative person(s) authorized by the parent(s); and
- 3) If the center is unable to make alternative arrangements, a staff member shall call the State Central Registry Hotline 1-877-652-2873 to seek assistance in caring for the child.
